- NO CHARGE for unlimited, over-the-counter teller cash withdrawals, down to the penny, at Visa or MasterCard member banks
- NO CHARGE to get cash back in stores with PIN code purchases
- Shop and pay bills directly using the ALINE Card or sign up for a separate online bill pay account from the bill pay provider.

- Pay with a single touch using the ALINE Card with Apple Pay® (if provisioned) in participating stores and in apps
- Access and manage their ALINE Card account onthe-go using the FREE ADP® Mobile Solutions App
- Deposit additional funds from other jobs, tax refunds, child support payments and more after passing an additional validation
