

## Installation

Use these procedures to download and install ACME Crib App. Ensure that you have watched the video linked in the overview before getting started.

### Installing ACME Crib app

1. From the Mongoose environment, go to **Select Form**.
2. In the **Filter** section, specify **deployment**.
3. Verify that the **Select by Name Instead of Caption** check box is selected and the **Case-sensitive** check box is cleared.
4. Select **Deployment** from the list.
5. Click **OK**.



6. In the Deploy Applet section, specify the location of the **Mongoose Crib App Demo.zip** file in the Source File field.

Optionally, click the ellipsis icon to locate the file.



7. Click **Execute Scripts**.
8. To unload your cache, click **Form** and select **Definition > Unload All Global Form Objects**.

Optionally, press Ctrl + U on your keyboard.

## Installing Form Sync

1. From the Mongoose environment, go to **Select Form**.
2. In the **Filter** section, specify **formsync**.
3. Verify that the **Select by Name Instead of Caption** check box is selected and the **Case-sensitive** check box is cleared.
4. Select **FormSync** from the list.
5. Click **OK**.



6. Select both **Source** and **Target** as your current environment.
7. Click **OK**.
8. Click **Utilities**.

## Installing Form Permissions

1. From the Mongoose environment, go to **Select Form**.
2. In the **Filter** section, specify **UsersMaint**.
3. Verify that the **Select by Name Instead of Caption** check box is selected and the **Case-sensitive** check box is cleared.
4. Select **UsersMaint** from the list.
5. Click **OK**.





7. Select a common group and click the **Group Authorizations** button.

For Single user access, click **User Authorization**.

8. Unload the cache for **ACME\_App**:
  - a. On the modal form pop-up, add a new record.
  - b. For the Object name, select or specify **ACME\_App**
  - c. Click **Save**.
  - d. Click **Form** and select **Definition > Unload All Global Form Objects**.
  
9. Unload the cache for **VAL\_ItemsTile**:
  - a. On the modal form pop-up, add a new record.
  - b. For the Object name, select or specify **ACME\_App**
  - c. Click **Save**.
  - d. Click **Form** and select **Definition > Unload All Global Form Objects**.



9. Click the **Licenses** tab and select **Refresh Form List**.
10. Scroll to find **ACME\_App** and **VAL\_ItemsTile** and select the check box.
11. Click **Generate Form License**.
12. To unload your cache, click **Form** and select **Definition > Unload All Global Form Objects**.

Optionally, press **Ctrl + U** on your keyboard.
